



Surface Emissions Monitoring Conducted at Colonial Landfill

SORRENTO, La. (July 23, 2019) – On July 8-9, 2019, surface emissions monitoring (SEM) evaluations were conducted at Colonial Landfill in accordance with the procedures in 40 CFR 60.755(c) and (d). Of these scans, there were three detections of methane in excess of 250 ppm during this two-day SEM evaluation.

Methane concentrations of 391, 302 and 311 ppm were recorded, along with a hydrogen sulfide readings of non-detect, 0.001 ppm and non-detect, at the corresponding locations. None of the methane readings met or exceeded the regulatory corrective action level.
